AFTER RUNNING THIS UPDATE: You MUST verify your FUTA and SUTA rates to ensure they are current for 2023. THE IRS AND STATE RULES CHANGE FREQUENTLY. Consult your TAX ADVISOR for their guidance and assistance with your rates.

**NOTE:** As of November 2022, the Department of Labor has provided the updated outstanding UI federal loans. As a result, employers in the following states will pay extra FUTA taxes that are effective <u>retroactively</u> to January 1, 2022. <a href="https://oui.doleta.gov/unemploy/futa\_credit.asp">https://oui.doleta.gov/unemploy/futa\_credit.asp</a>.

Please note that the actual 2023 rates will not be published by the U.S. Department of Labor until **November 2023**. Once published, they will <u>retroactively</u> be effective to <u>1/1/2023</u>. Depending your state's ability to repay their loan to the Federal government will dictate an increase or a decrease. We recommend that you use the above 2023 COATS FUTA Rate.
